

**Hui-a-owners  
Hui-a-beneficiaries**

The Māori Land Court has directed that a hui-a-owners take place for the sole purpose of an Election of Trustees, for each of the following Māori Reservations:

**Whakapoungakau No 7A  
Whakapoungakau 7B2  
Whakapoungakau 7C  
Whakapoungakau 7F  
Whakapoungakau 7G**

There will be five separate hui to elect trustees to each of the respective blocks.

All hui will take place on **Saturday 5 August 2023**. Further details will be advertised closer to the date.

Nominations to become a trustee must be **received in writing, 10-working days prior to the hui taking place.**

Nominations:

- Must be received on the official Māori Land Court nomination form
- Forms can be obtained by either contacting the Māori Land Court or by way of the link, details for both are below
- Must be received by the Māori Land Court on or before **4pm Friday, 21 July 2023**
- Nominations must clearly identify the block to which the person is being nominated to.

Trustee nominations must include:

- The written signature of both the nominator, seconder, and the nominee
- Details of the nominee's full name, address and contact number.

First notice and second calling of nominations

- Will be advertised on 24 July 2023 confirming the date, times, and venue for all of the above hui.
- A second calling of nominations.

Second notice

- Will be advertised on 31 July
- Confirming the date, times, and venue for all the hui, and include
- The names of the nominees for each of the blocks
