T Wetere for Deputy Registrar: The above-named matter was set down for a Judicial Conference on 4 December 2026 at 10.00 am at the Māori Land Court, Whangārei.

On 5 August 2026, the Court provided notice of the Judicial Conference to all parties.

On 7 August 2026, the respondent, Mr Duane Monk, advised the Court that he would be out of the country and would not return until 5 December 2026.

To avoid disruption to the fixture, the Court subsequently invited Mr Monk to attend the Judicial Conference by online means. Mr Monk advised that he would be able to attend remotely but requested that the time of the Judicial Conference be adjusted to accommodate the three-to-four-hour time difference.

Mr Monk also sought assistance through the Special Aid Fund to obtain legal representation at the Judicial Conference.

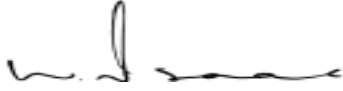
The matter was referred to Judge Isaac for further direction. Following consideration of Mr Monk's availability and the Court's hearing schedule, Judge Isaac directed that the Judicial Conference be brought forward to 3 December 2026 at 2.00 pm, which will enable Mr Monk to participate by online means while allowing the matter to be accommodated within the Court's hearing schedule.

Judge Isaac also approved Mr Monk being permitted to apply for assistance from the Special Aid Fund for legal representation in relation to the Judicial Conference.

Accordingly, the Judicial Conference previously set down for 4 December 2026 at 10.00 am be adjourned and re-set to 3 December 2026 at 2.00 pm, to be conducted at the Māori Land Court, Whangārei, with Mr Monk permitted to attend by online means.

Pursuant to rule 6.9(1)(a) of the Māori Land Court Rules 2011 the application is adjourned accordingly
